You will also require:

Smooth work surface (glass or ceramic) ,Aluminium foil, Paintbrush

Instruction for Christmas baubles with effect



1 Create a ball out of aluminium foil (slightly larger than the required final size). Wrap a thin (approx. 1-2 mm) sheet of FIMO around it.

Smooth over any unevenness with the acrylic roller. Add a second layer of FIMO if necessary.



2 Roll leaf green FIMO to an approx. 1 mm thick sheet and use the shaped cutters to cut stars and hearts out of it.



3 Apply gold powder to the stars and hearts using the paintbrush. You can leave some plain - without gold - if you like.

Stick them onto the bauble and harden in the oven for 30 minutes at 110°C. Then add a protective coat of gloss varnish to the golden elements.

Tip:

Unfinished items and left-over bits of material can be stored in a sealed plastic bag or airtight container, e.g. a plastic box or jar.

Instruction for Christmas baubles with effect



For the ,snail' baubles, roll thin strings of FIMO (approx. 3 mm in diameter) to different-sized coils and position closely together on the bauble.

Fill in the gaps with more bits of FIMO string. Decorate with gold powder if desired and harden in the oven for 30 minutes at 110°C.



Instruction for Stylish Serviette Rings



Roll out 4 strips of carmine-coloured FIMO to a flat sheet and cut off an approx. 14 x 3 cm wide stripe.

Cut a star out of another stripe using the shaped cutter and then use the blade to cut around it approx. 3 mm from the edge.



Shape the FIMO stripe to a ring and smooth over the join well on the inside and outside.

Brush gold powder onto the cut-out stars and press them onto the ring.

Stylish Serviette Rings

For a festive table decoration, pull the serviette rings over cream-coloured napkins and arrange them on the plates along with your custom-made baubles.

Merry Christmas!

Tip:

For better stability, slide the FIMO ring onto an empty roll of toilet paper. Then harden in the oven for 30 minutes at 110°C. Varnish when cool.
